October 14, 2013: Our pilgrimage-tour to Italy begins as we depart from Omaha International or Kansas City International Airport for an overnight flight to Rome, Italy.

Oct. 15: Upon arrival in Rome we'll have a sight-seeing tour of the Eternal City, such as the Colosseum, Arch of Constantine, the Roman Forum, giving us a general overview of Rome. Hotel check in followed by relaxation before dinner. **Overnight Rome.**

Oct. 16: Today we will go to Vatican City and the Papal Audience (subject to the Pope's schedule). In the early afternoon we'll have a guided tour of the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica. **Overnight Rome.**

Oct. 17: Today we will visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the Church of St. Peter in Chains and the Basilica of St. John Lateran. This afternoon is at leisure to roam Rome on your own. **Overnight Rome.**

Oct. 18: Today is the 25th Anniversary of the order's founding and we will participate in a Solemn Mass of Thanksgiving at the Fraternity of St. Peter's Rome Parish. The remainder of the day is at leisure to roam Rome on your own. **Overnight Rome.**

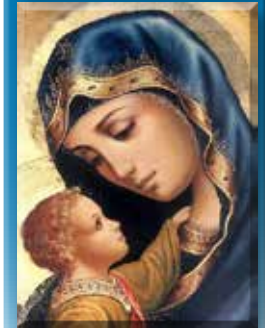
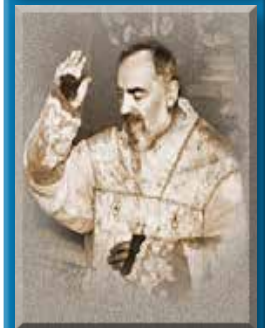
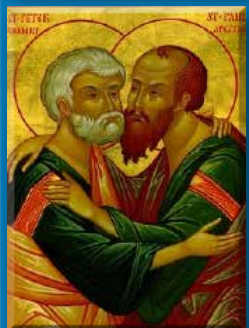
Oct. 19: Depart Rome to visit San Giovanni Rotondo, the town made famous by St. Padre Pio. En-route we'll visit the Sanctuary of St. Philomena located in Mugnano del Cardinale where the earthly remains of St. Philomena rest. While in San Giovanni Rotondo we'll visit the church of Santa Maria della Grazie to pray at the tomb of St. Padre Pio, the priest who bore Our Lord's Stigmata. **Overnight San Giovanni Rotondo.**

Oct. 20: Morning departure for Mass in Lanciano site of the Eucharistic Miracle. Continue to Cascia for Mass at the Basilica of Saint Rita. We will arrive in Assisi, home and foundation of the Franciscan Order in time for dinner. **Overnight Assisi.**

Oct. 21: We'll spend the day in Assisi visiting the Basilica of St. Francis followed by a guided tour. Next, visit St. Mary of the Angels where St. Francis spent most of his life. We'll visit the Chapel Portiuncola, the rose bush and the cave. **Overnight Assisi.**

Oct. 22: Today we'll visit the Medieval city of Siena, home of St. Catherine. We'll visit her Cathedral and also adore the Eucharistic Miracle of Siena, consecrated hosts that have remained uncorrupted for more than 200 years. Farewell dinner. **Overnight Assisi.**

Oct. 23: With a renewed sense of pilgrimage, and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we'll board our plane for the return flight home.

TOUR CONDITIONS & INFORMATION: Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared in advance and are subject to change at any time. Activities are planned and scheduled according to the best information available at the time.

Tour prices: All prices are based on 2012 pricing. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust prices should there be any significant increases in: (1) Airfare due to higher fuel costs etc.. (2) Ground costs due to possible increases in hotel charges and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and final Payments: A deposit of \$400.00 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200.00 is non-refundable. Your deposit forms part of your final payment which is due 75 days prior to departure date. Payment can be made by check or credit card. Credit card payments will be charged an additional fee (3%) to process the payment. To make a credit card payment contact Canterbury.

Cancellation fees: If cancellation in writing is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 75 days prior to departure all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less \$200.00 initial deposit. For cancellations received within 75 days prior to departure the following cancellation fee applies: \$400.00 (initial deposit) plus any applicable charges imposed by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours the airlines, hotels, and bus companies. Please note that the amount varies with each tour. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any tour up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned promptly.

Baggage: Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the tour. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase to exceed 50 pounds (this may change), and if the weight is more the penalties are very high. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains and stations. Please follow the general rule of traveling light and if you cannot carry it do not bring it. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage.

Travel insurance: Although seldom used, we strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident / trip cancellation / baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. cannot accept responsibility for accidents, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Access America Travel Insurance.

Gratuities: Gratuities to porter for luggage and servers for meals are included in tour price. The customary gratuity to motorcoach chauffeur, tour host, local guides, chambermaids, etc., is not included in tour price and should be extended on an individual, voluntary basis. Items such as room service, laundry, telephone calls, etc., are not included.
